Alex Kisha passed away peacefully on the morning of August 6 on the Feast Day of the Transfiguration. His last days were filled with the reading of the Psalms and music from Pascha. He was born in East Springfield, Ohio and raised on a beautiful farm in Wolf Run, Ohio by his parents the late John and Anna Kisha. After graduating from Amsterdam High School and Bowling Green University, Alex joined the United States Army, where he retired as a Major. As an army officer, Alex served on the faculty, did research for moon explorations during the 1960 era, and was instrumental in doing research on stealth bombers and submarine sonar. Alex settled in Columbus, Ohio where he was a senior professor of electrical engineering for the DeVry University. He was also an avid HAMM Radio Operator and enjoyed communicating with people from all over the world. He was a lifelong member of All Saints Orthodox Church in Wolf Run, Ohio, a parish where his parents were founding members.

Alex was preceded in death by his mother and father and siblings, Mary, Michael, Peter, John, George, Joe, Nick, Andy, Steve, Paul, and Sam. Alex is survived by his brother Theodore and sister-in-law Anna, and many nieces, nephews, great nieces, and great nephews.
