Alice Rutledge Poplin, 66, of Carrollton, passed away Sunday afternoon August 14, 2022 at Aultman Hospital in Canton following a brief illness.

A daughter of the late R. Herb and Pat Eick Rutledge, she was born December 6, 1955 in Canton, Ohio.

Alice was a 1974 graduate of Carrollton High School. After graduation she went on to earn her degree in Family and Consumer Sciences from The Ohio State University in 1978, then in 2008 she obtained a Masters Degree in Education from Kent State University. Over her 35 year career she taught at both Conotton Valley High School and Carrollton High School, finishing her career where she started, as a Warrior.
