Beth Ann Kaufholz, 55 of Canton went to be with her Savior on Saturday, June 1st, 2019, at Aultman Hospital in Canton.

She was born on June 29th, 1963 in Mount Vernon, to the late Charles and Lois (Nicholson) Green, Sr.

Beth grew up in Heath, Ohio, and graduated from Heath High School. She also lived in Newark, Carrollton, Perrysville, and Canton.
