Betty B. Danley, 89, of Carrollton died Thursday morning September 15, 2011 at Aultman Hospital in Canton after an extended illness. Born March 30, 1922 in Carrollton, Ohio she was a daughter of the late Isaac and Cora Bell Dray Moore. Betty was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church in Carrollton and the Eagles Auxiliary #2185.
