Carl E. Hepner, 80, of Carrollton, went on to be with the Lord on May 18, 2023.

The son of William (Bill) and Betty (Lucas) Hepner, he was born on May 14, 1943 in Carroll County.

Carl attended and was active at the Carrollton Bible Chapel for 23 years. He graduated from Carrollton High School in 1963. He married Lula (Lou) Graham in August, 1963. He worked through junior high and high school doing various jobs such as setting up pins at Carroll Lanes, and working at Al's stocking shelves and bagging groceries.
