June 9, 1924 - December 11, 2010

Charles Ray Long, 86, of Carrollton passed away Saturday, December 11, 2010 at home on his farm. A son of the late Charles Denton and Margaret McCort Long, he was born June 9, 1924 in Lee Township, Carroll County. In the late 1940s Ray began driving a milk truck delivering to the Hollywood Candy Company in Malvern, Ohio. He then went to work for the James' Brothers Coal Company, before going to work for the Ohio Department of Transportation in 1963, and retiring from there in 1987. Ray enjoyed farming and raising milk cows before switching to beef cattle in the mid 1990s. Ray is survived by his wife, the former Rhoda M. White, whom he married October 19, 1948; also surviving are two sisters, Helen Myers and Shirley Beiber; and numerous nieces and nephews. Along with his parents he is preceded in death by a brother, Carl D. Long; and a sister, Dorothy Hendrix. Funeral services will be Thursday, December 16, 2010 at 11:00 a.m. in Sweeney-Dodds Funeral Home with Rev. Kimberly Albaugh officiating. Burial will follow in Harlem Springs Cemetery. Visitation will be Wednesday from 2-4 and 6-8 p.m. in the funeral home.
