Dale H. Noble, 91, died Saturday, February 28, 2015 at Aultman Compassionate Care in Canton. A son of the late Charles and Niva Blazer Noble, he was born March 6, 1923 in Lee Township, Ohio. Dale was a Army Veteran of WWII and had retired from Diebold after 42 years of service.
