Sue was one of the best cooks of all time and she was totally in her element when in her kitchen preparing a meal for her family. There was no such thing as a small meal, it was a meal to eat and a meal for everyone to take home with them and then leftovers! In addition to her parents and son Todd, Sue was preceded in death by her stepfather, whom she loved and respected dearly, Donald Borland.

Sue is survived by her husband Bill, her son Scott, grandsons Braden and Bryce Yoder & their mother, Tonya Griffiths Phillips. Also, her siblings, Gary (Donna) Hall, Donnie (Anita) Borland and Cindy Triplett-Dominick. She has several nieces and nephews as well and a very close and "special" friendship with Sarah Alley from Canton and Janet Tasker from Corry, PA. Sarah was like a daughter to Sue and Janet and Sue had been friends since grade school.
