Dana Sue Yoder of Carrollton passed away May 26, 2026, at the Aultman Woodlawn Compassionate Care Center. She fought her disease with grace, dignity and determination. She won the battle and now she rests in the arms of Jesus.

She was born in Beckley, West Virginia on February 24, 1947 to the late Macie and Stanton Hall.

After graduating from Carrollton High School in 1965 she married her high school sweetheart, Bill Yoder on February 26, 1966. Together they had two sons, Todd Addison Yoder who preceded her in death and Scott Yoder.

Sue worked for Dr. Darrell Locke for nearly 30 years and Dr. Brady Kail (Waynesburg) for 20 years. She loved her jobs and she loved both doctors very much. She continued to work until two months ago when her health just did not permit.

While Sue loved her jobs and loved working, nothing could compare to the love she had for her family. Her family was her world, especially her son, Scott Yoder and grandsons, Braden and Bryce Yoder.

Sue had one of the biggest hearts imaginable to go with her sometimes fiery

personality.

Sue was a very generous lady with a very big heart and expected nothing in return except love.

Sue was one of the best cooks of all time and she was totally in her element when in her kitchen preparing a meal for her family. There was no such thing as a small meal, it was a meal to eat and a meal for everyone to take home with them and then leftovers! When we mention big meals....18 pies for Thanksgiving to feed a total of 13 people.

In addition to her parents and son Todd, Sue was preceded in death by her stepfather, whom she loved and respected dearly, Donald Borland.

Sue is survived by her husband Bill, her son Scott, grandsons Braden and Bryce Yoder & their mother, Tonya Griffiths Phillips. Also, her siblings, Gary (Donna) Hall, Donnie (Anita) Borland and Cindy Triplett-Dominick. She has several nieces and nephews as well and a very close and "special" friendship with Sarah Alley from Canton and Janet Tasker from Corry, PA. Sarah was like a daughter to Sue and Janet and Sue had been friends since grade school.

A memorial service will take place on Saturday, May 30, 2026, at the Church of Christ – Christian Disciples at 353 Moody Ave. Carrollton, Ohio with visitation from 10 – 11 and the Memorial Service at 11:00 AM with Pastor Mark Stater officiating.

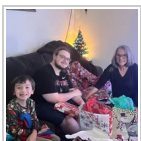
