David L. Thomas, 78, of Carrollton died Saturday evening in Aultman Hospital, Canton, Ohio. Born September 17, 1935 in Sherrodsville, Ohio, he was a son of the late Wilbur and Ella Jane Edie Thomas. Dave was a retired rural letter carrier, with 35 years of service, for the U.S. Postal Service, Carrollton Office, where he was known as the whistling mailman. He was an Army veteran of the Korean Conflict.
