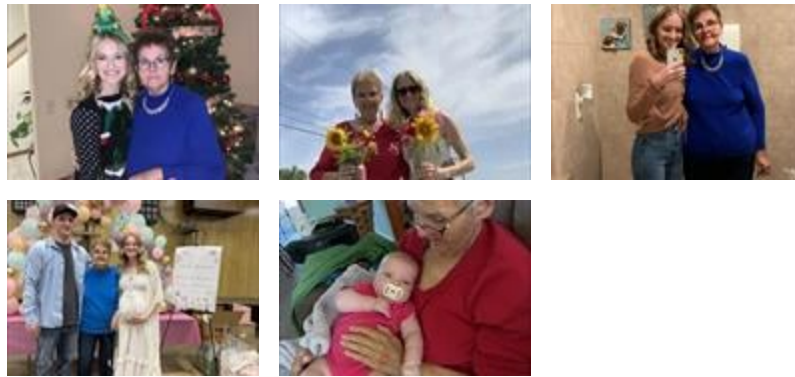

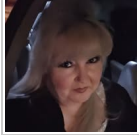

You're beautiful both inside and out.

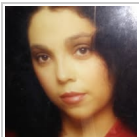
