Edith L. Morvatz, 87, of Carrollton, died on April 27, 2014 at the Carroll Golden Age Retreat. Born May 18, 1926 in Augusta, Ohio, she was the daughter of Chalmer and Icie Sell. She graduated from Carrollton High School in 1944. Edith worked in the banking industry for over 40 years at the Cummings, First National, Harter, and Society Banks in Carrollton.
