



Eugene "Gene" Gavorcik

November 10, 1927 - October 22, 2013

Eugene A. Gavorcik, 85, passed away October 22, 2013 at Aultman Hospital after a third bout with cancer. Gene, as he was known, was born November 10, 1927, at Adena, OH, the son of the late Carl and Theresa Runevich Gavorcik. He attended Cadiz High School but later graduated from Perrysville High School. After graduation in 1945, he enlisted in the Air Force. Once his term was served he came home and married his high school sweetheart, Elaine Walters, with whom he spent 63 years of marriage . Gene graduated from the Cleveland School of Electronics and was employed by RCA for two years, then moved to Canton, Ohio and worked 10 years for Lister TV as their service man. His last employment was with Village TV in Carrollton, Ohio where he worked for 30 years before retiring. Gene had a great love for country music and enjoyed playing his banjo with the Carroll County Gang. After his retirement, he had a daily appointment for 10 a.m. at Archer's Restaurant in Carrollton with the "Round Table." He is survived by his wife; a sister, Joan Spiker of Scio; and numerous nieces and nephews. Along with his parents he was preceded in death by a brother, Anthony Gavorcik, and a sister, Florence Huey. Funeral services will be Saturday, October 26, 2013 at 1:00 p.m. in Sweeney-Dodds Funeral Home of Carrollton with Rev. Charles M. Horn officiating. Burial will follow in Perrysville Cemetery. Visitation will be Friday evening from 5-8 p.m. in the funeral home.
