Francis Joseph "Frank" Clark, 83, of Clover Rd., Mechanicstown, died Tuesday, April 20, 2010, in the Hospice inpatient unit at Union Hospital at Dover following a brief illness. Born Feb. 13, 1927, in Zoar, Ohio, he was a son of the late Thomas and Grace Palmer Clark. Frank was a retired carpenter and was also retired from the Eljer Co. of Salem, Ohio. He was an Army veteran of World War II. He was a member of the Corinth Presbyterian Church in Mechanicstown.
