Frank Bick Jr., 85, of Kilgore passed away Sunday afternoon September 21, 2014 in the Carroll Golden Age Retreat surrounded by his family following a prolonged illness. A son of the late Frank Sr. and Josephine Kolek Bik, he was born in Jefferson County, Ohio. Frank was a veteran of the U.S. Army having served during the Korean Conflict. He held several jobs including running his own feed store, operating a farm, driving bus for Carrollton Schools, and worked for Ohio Department of Transportation. Frank was a former Loudon Township Trustee and founding member of the Kilgore Fire Department.
