Gerard M. Jellick, 65, of Carrollton died Sunday morning October 23, 2016 in Mercy Medical Center following a one year illness. Born September 30, 1951 in Uniontown, Pennsylvania, he was the son of Dorothy Jellick of Kilgore and the late Michael James Jellick.
