Golda Scott, 101, of Carrollton died Wednesday afternoon in the Carroll Healthcare Center following an extended illness. A life resident of Carroll County she was born in Lee Township, Carroll County, July 4 1910, a daughter of the late Anson and Belle Beckley Donaldson. She was preceded in death by her husband, Dwight, on May 21, 2003, to whom she was married to for 69 years.
