Harold "Toby" Davis, 78, of Carrollton, passed away unexpectedly in his home, early Tuesday morning December 3, 2024.

A son of the late Alice Taggart Davis he was born January 17, 1946 in Steubenville, Ohio.

Toby was a Navy veteran having served in Vietnam. He was a retired truck driver and retired Assistant Fire Chief for the former Carroll County Volunteer Fire Department. He was a past member of the Scio Fire Department, Minerva VFW, Malvern American Legion, the 40\8, and was active with the Military Honor Guard and Firing Squad.
