Howard Simon Shepherd, 89, of Bergholz died Saturday, August 18, 2018 in Presbyterian Hospital at Pittsburgh. Born December 28, 1928 in Jefferson County, he was a son of the late William and Gladys Cox Shepherd.

An Army veteran of the Korean Conflict, Howard was a retired truck driver and contractor. He was a member of the Christ United Methodist Church in East Springfield, the East Springfield Senior Citizens Association, where he had served as President, and was President of the East Springfield Ruritans. One of his projects that he loved was organizing the annual Memorial Day parade in East Springfield.
