



## Isabell Garner

November 9, 1911 - June 20, 2010

Much to her own great relief, Isabell Garner, 98, of Third St. SE Carrollton left her worldly woes behind early Sunday morning June 20, 2010 in her home following a four and one half year illness. She was November 9, 1911 in Bradys Bend, Pennsylvania a daughter of the late Christopher and Mazina Lash Barger. Isabell and her husband Lawrence were married in 1930 and he died in March of 1981, shortly after they celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary. They had resided in Pennsylvania, Harlem Springs, Ohio, California, and Nevada before returning to Carrollton in 1980. The couple were former members of the Church of God. Prior to her illness Isabell enjoyed going to the Algonquin Mill and the Friendship Center for weekly quilting days. She is survived by four daughters, Winona B. DeLair of Streetsboro, Ohio, P. Ruth (Carl) Noble of Harlem Springs, Mary E. (Raymon) Dunlap of Carrollton, Vaunda L. Eidem Spaulding of Ogden, Utah; eleven grandchildren; eighteen great grandchildren; sister-in-law, Icle Scott of Winterhaven , Florida. In addition to her husband Isabell was preceded in death by three sisters, three brothers and three very dear sons-in-law Dean DeLair, Gene Spaulding, and Rudy Eidem Funeral services will be Tuesday at 1:00 p.m. in Sweeney-Dodds Funeral Home of Carrollton with Pastor Doug Snode officiating.
