J. Dale Williamson, 86, of Malabar, Florida formerly of Carrollton died Wednesday November 2, 2011 in Florida. Born June 5, 1925 in Toronto, Ohio he was a son of the late Ralph and Elma Palmer Williamson. Dale was a Navy veteran of WWII. He was the superintendent for the Carroll County Home from 1949-1968, he then operated Williamson refuse from 1964-1982. Dale also served as a Carroll County Commissioner from 1979-1983, and as the manager for the county job training program 1983-1989. Dale was a charter member of the Carrollton Ruritan Club, a member of the Carrollton VFW, and American Legion and the Carroll County VETS Club. In addition to his fraternal clubs Dale enjoyed traveling, fishing, and sports. He is survived by his wife, the former Arletta Merinar, whom he married June 1, 1947, a son, J.D. Williamson of Ft. Lauderdale, Florida; three daughters, Cheryl Geiser of Carrollton, Cindy (Dale) Wade of Malabar, Florida, Tammy (Brad) Brookes of Longmont, Colorado; ten grandchildren; seven great grandchildren; and a brother, Wayne "Jake" Williamson of Carrollton. In addition to his parents Dale was preceded in death by two brothers, Carl and Jimmy. Funeral services will be Tuesday at 11: 00 a.m. in Sweeney-Dodds Funeral Home at Carrollton with Pastor Elaine Painting officiating. Burial will follow in the Westview Cemetery at Carrollton with full Military honors. Visitation will be Monday from 4-8 P M and one hour prior to the service in the funeral home.
