James Andrew Baxter, 81, a lifetime resident of Amsterdam, Ohio, passed away quietly on August 3, 2022, attended by his niece Marianne and brother-in-law Bob.

He was determined to not let this interfere with his life and learned to walk despite the doctors' predictions. James led an active life, spending time traveling and hunting, an activity he enjoyed with his friends. He also worked as a pressman at Carroll Graphics in Carrollton. In his later years, James became active in genealogy and helped many people with their research in Carroll and Jefferson Counties.

James was preceded in death by his parents and his sister Alyce. His is survived by his brother-in-law, Bob Boggess, niece Marianne (Cody) Burns, nephews Bob (Joy) Boggess, Dave (Cindy) Boggess and Tom (Alisha) Boggess. He is also survived by 8 grandnieces and nephews and a great grandniece and 2 great grandnephews.
