Joseph Webb The streets of Amsterdam are missing the familiar face of Joseph (Joe) Webb, born in Steubenville, Ohio on June 4, 1934 to the late Fred and Agnes Webb. Joe, 79, went to be with the Lord on Sunday, January 12, 2014, after a brief illness. Joe was a 1953 graduate of Amsterdam High School. He was a member of the Amsterdam Church of God. He served in the US Army, until receiving an honorable medical discharge. He retired from Jefferson County Health Department, where he worked as a sanitarian for 32 years. Joe loved his family, hunting, fishing, golfing, and bowling. He rolled the very first 300 game at Amsterdam's Garson Lanes in 1981. Joe is survived by his wife of 57 years, Mary Katherine (Everly) Webb, daughter, Sharon (Webb) Temple of Mingo Junction, Ohio, son Roger (Marlene) Webb of Massillon, grandchildren: Morgan (Temple) Adkins, Austin Temple, Adam Webb, and Evan Seese, and great-grandson: Kendall Adkins. He was preceded in death by his parents, 3 brothers: Fred Jr., Jack, Owen, and 3 sisters: May Baker, Edith Kohler, and Irene Mills.
