Joyce J. Hannon, 76, of Carrollton died Wednesday, January 7, 2009 in her home following an extended illness. A daughter of the late Edward and Mabel Wills Yetka, she was born November 27, 1932 in New Kensington, Pennsylvania. Joyce was the founder, owner, and operator of Bluebird Farm and Amphitheater and member of the Carrollton First United Methodist Church. She was a strong supporter of the arts in Carrollton and the students of Carrollton High School through the establishment of an annual scholarship award.
