Judd graduated from Carrollton High School in 1952, Capital University with a B.S. in Chemistry in 1956, University of Akron in 1957 with a M.S. in Chemistry and in 1961 with a PhD in Polymer Science. Judd operated several family businesses in Carrollton including Surety Rubber Company, Hall Industries and Turn Cuff Corporation. After which, he worked as a chemist/consultant for several glove and manufacturing facilities both overseas and in South America as well as drove vehicles for Guess Motors in Carrollton. He was married to the love of his life, the late Betty J. Hall for 27 years. He is preceded in death by his father, Judd B. Hall; mother, Gladys Hall; and best friend, Scott Slates. He is survived by a stepson, Robert V. James; a beloved daughter, Belinda K.
