Karma Evanosky passed away peacefully at The Oaks at Northpointe, Zanesville OH on September 9, 2024 at the age of 83.

Born on June 22, 1941, Karma was a lifelong resident of Amsterdam, OH. She was a retired millworker from Titanium Metals Corporation (TIMET) of Toronto, OH, where she endured an exhausting swing shift schedule and, as the sole provider for her three children, tolerated working in an environment antagonistic to women.
