



## Kenneth C. Beckley

February 12, 1918 - April 20, 2015

Kenneth C. Beckley, 96, of Carrollton died Monday, April 20, 2015 in the Carroll Healthcare Center at Carrollton.

Born February 12, 1918 in Lee Township, Carroll County, he was a son of the late James and Hazel Gregg Beckley.

Kenneth was a former employee of the Carroll Electric Co-op with 35 years of service retiring in December 1982. He was a WWII Army Veteran, serving with the rank of Sargent in the 4000th AAF Base Unit as an aerial photographer from February 1942 thru October 1945.

Kenneth was preceded in death by his wife the former Florence Haladay on November 12, 2011.

He is survived by many nieces and nephews.
