Larry Lee Calderhead, 78, of Carroll County, passed away peacefully at his home on October 31, 2025, surrounded by his family.

Born April 12, 1947, he was the son of Kenneth and Katherine (Brackin) Calderhead, who preceded him in death.

Larry was a lifelong resident of Carroll County and a 1965 graduate of Carrollton High School. He served in Vietnam until 1968 and later retired from HP Products in Louisville in 2012.

In 1990, Larry was baptized as one of Jehovah's Witnesses and served faithfully to the end.
