Mark Alan Stoughton, 56, of Amsterdam died in his home early December 10, 2015

after suffering an apparent heart attack. Born January 20, 1959 in Vandergrift, Pennsylvania, he was a son of L. Andrew Stoughton, Sr. formerly of Toronto, Ohio now residing in Harrisville, Pennsylvania and the late Jean Kurten Stoughton.

Mark was a telecommunications manager for the Donor Care Center of Minerva, Ohio, a former deputy sheriff of Stark County, and a former volunteer fireman with the Toronto Fire Department.
