



Metro "Jack" Kochan

September 28, 1923 - June 10, 2014

Metro "Jack" Kochan passed from death to life on Tuesday afternoon. He was born to Ignati and Julianna (Halkovich) Kochan on September 28, 1923 in Wolf Run. He was a lifelong member of All Saints Orthodox Church in Wolf Run where he served as President for 25 years. For all of his dedicated service to the church he was awarded a Gramota by Metropolitan Theodosius. Jack was retired from Standard Slag after 37 years of service, and was a veteran of WWII. He was preceded by his beloved wife of 63 years, Elizabeth (Gregor); sister, Ann (Narus); brothers, John, Nick, and Sam; and best friend, Basil Kuzemchak. He is survived by his sisters, Tillie, Olga (Sabula); brother, Mike; and sister-in-law, Carma Mills. He leaves behind his children, Greg (Dianne), loving daughter and caregiver, Sonja (Bill) Mullen, and Basil (Lori) Kochan; and grandchildren, Jennifer (Cory), Meredith, Andrea, David, Sarah (Cole), and Andrew. Funeral services will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Friday, June 13 at All Saints Orthodox Church in Wolf Run with Fr. Evgeni Peykov officiating. Burial will follow in All Saints Cemetery with full military honors. Visitation will be Thursday from 4-8 p.m. in Dodds Funeral Home of Amsterdam with Parastas at 7:30 p.m., and also from 10 a.m. until time of service in the church Friday morning.
