Michele Faith (Cain) DeBold, 55, of East Springfield, Ohio has left this world and went to her eternal home in heaven. After an 11 year battle with ovarian cancer, she passed away at home on Thursday, March 12, surrounded by her loving family.

Michele was born on June 21, 1959 to Gary and Margaret Cain, also of East Springfield. In addition to her parents, Michele is survived by her husband, Joseph, whom she married on August 7, 1982; two children, Allison (Scott) Pickett of Dublin, OH and Eric DeBold of Columbus, OH; one granddaughter, Madison Pickett; her brother, Brad (Tammy) Cain and his children, Devlin, Taylor, and Shaylyn. She also leaves behind Joe's mother, sisters and their husbands, and several nieces and nephews whom she loved dearly.

Michele was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Amsterdam, OH. She worked for over half her life in the family business, Gary W. Cain Realtors & Auctioneers, in multiple roles as realtor, antique appraiser and auction bookkeeper. Her passion and knowledge of antiques led her to become an active member in the De-He-Wa-Mis Questers organization. She loved animals and especially enjoyed riding horses. Michele joined the Chi Omega fraternity at West Liberty College during her four years there and continued many lasting friendships with her sisters long after graduation.

A Catholic Mass will take place at 11:00 a.m. on Monday, March 16 at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Amsterdam with Fr. Jack McCoy officiating. Interment will follow in East Springfield Cemetery. Friends will be received at Dodds Funeral Home in Amsterdam on Sunday, March 15 from 4-8 p.m. and on Monday from 10-11 a.m. at St. Joseph Catholic Church.
