Paul Elden Guess, 80, of Carrollton died Tuesday evening July 23, 2013 in his home. Born January 30, 1933 in Carrollton, Ohio, he was a son of the late Theodore and Florence Staley Guess. Paul was a businessman, developer, and avid promoter of Carrollton. He owned and operated Guess Motors in Carrollton along with the Carrollton Ponderosa Restaurant, and was a developer of homes in the Village of Carrollton as well as an original investor in the Days Inn Hotel of Carrollton. He had served in the United States Air Force.
