Paul W. Jakubowski, 91, of Carrollton, passed away Thursday morning October 12, 2023 at the Ashtabula County Medical Center in Ashtabula, Ohio.

Born April 29, 1932 in Salineville, Ohio, Paul was a son of the late Adam R. and Stella Gruszecki Jakubowski.

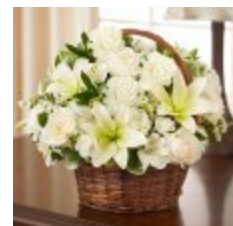
