Peter Horshok, 92, of Carrollton died May 2, 2011 in Mercy Medical Center at Canton. Peter has been a resident at the Carroll Golden Age Retreat since August of 2006. Born February 9, 1919 in Lorain, Ohio he was a son of the late Wasyl and Mary Kovalition Horshok. His family resided in the Amsterdam area and he attended the Simmons Ridge, Kilgore, and Amsterdam Schools. He then became a coal miner with the Y&O Coal Company until WWII when he joined the U.S. Marines serving in the pacific theater of operations and receiving a purple heart. Following his service in the marines he moved to Dearborn, Michigan and worked for GM in the Cadillac plant for 30 years prior to his retirement. Following retirement Peter moved to Oscoda, Michigan to be near Lake Huron where he could pursue his love of fishing. During his retirement years he returned to the Carroll County area often to visit and eventually moved here permanently to be close to his family. Peter is survived by his brother, George (Una) Horshok of Lisman, Alabama; sister-in-law, Rosie Horshok of Carrollton; his closest nieces Rosebud (Terry) Howell and Tammy (David) Booth both of Kilgore and Sophia (Albert) Horkey of Bergholz; he is also survived by many other nieces and nephews and grand nieces and nephews. During his stay at the Golden Age retreat he became friends with the many staff members and residents. In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by two sisters, Mary and Eleanor; and four brothers, Mike, John, Harry, and Steve.
