



Ralph "Pete" Hull

June 27, 1927 - April 19, 2011

Ralph E. (Pete) Hull, 83, passed away in his home Tuesday morning after an extended illness. Ralph was born in Mechanicstown on June 27, 1927 to Lloyd and Ruby Ray Hull. He married Donna Mae Lowther on July 19, 1947. He was a farmer all his life. Ralph drove bus for the Carrollton School system for eight years in the 1950s; and was a driver/equipment operator for local coal companies for several years. Ralph was best known for his knowledge and extreme skill with heavy equipment. He owned and operated Ralph Hull Excavating for 40 plus years with the help of his family. He had been a member of Carrollton Eagles and the Fox Township Volunteer Fire Department and was a member and elder of Corinth Presbyterian Church. In addition to his wife, Donna, Ralph is survived by a brother, Ray; two sisters, Wilma (Lewis) Grigsby and Etta Mae (Ronald) Peterson all of Carrollton; daughter, Gilda Long of Minerva and Jack Long of Canton; two sons, Homer (Vicki) of Carrollton and Robert (Debra) of Mechanicstown; eleven grandchildren and thirteen great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents and three infant children. Funeral services will be Saturday, April 23, 2011 at 11:00 a.m. in Sweeney-Dodds Funeral Home.
