Richard Calvin Jones Sr, 87, of Scio died early Friday morning January 10, 2014 in the Great Trail Care Center following an extended illness. Born December 31, 1926 in Weirton, West Virginia, he was a son of the late Edward L. and Clara Wahl Jones. Rich was retired from Weirton Steel where he had served as the foreman of both the Torch Repair Shop and the Scale/Pump Repair Shops. He also worked as a consultant/sales rep. for National Torch Tip Co. in Pittsburgh. Devoted to his family and a hard worker, Rich also operated a 203 acre farm while working in the mill and after retirement. Rich was an avid hunter and loved the outdoors. He also was an accomplished woodworker and carver.
