



## Richard "Dick" Stertzbach

Richard "Dick" Stertzbach, 81, of Carrollton, passed away on Thursday, March 7, 2024 in Haines City Florida.

Born on January 18, 1943 in Stark County, Ohio, he was a son of the late Harold Edward and Dorothy Dean (Douglas) Stertzbach Sr.

Dick was a veteran of the United States Army Reserves which he enlisted in after graduating High School in 1961 and was a member of the 350th Evacuation Hospital Unit in Canton, Ohio.
