Richard "Dick" Young, 89, of Carrollton passed away early Friday morning June 30, 2017 in the Carroll Healthcare Center.

A son of the late Clyde and Glenna Adams Young, he was born July 3, 1927 in Salineville, Ohio.

During the his life Dick was a very active member of his community, volunteering to join or work with clubs and organizations to get projects done that would benefit the families and kids of Carrollton.
