



## Robert M. Beckley

March 27, 1913 - September 24, 2010

Robert M. Beckley, 97, of Kent, formerly of Atwood Lake and Florida, died Friday morning, September 24, 2010, in Robinson Memorial Hospital at Ravenna following an extended illness. Born March 27, 1913, in Carrollton, he was a son of the late Samuel and Odessa Marshall Beckley. Robert was a career Navy veteran active from 1932 until 1959 serving overseas in both World War II and the Korean Conflict. Following his Naval retirement he attended University of Miami in Florida and became a real estate appraiser and broker. He was a member of Christ Community Church in Dellroy and the Atwood Yacht Club.
