December 8, 1923 - February 6, 2015

Ruth Neider, 91, of Carrollton went home to be with her Lord early Friday morning, February 6, 2015 at the Carroll Healthcare Center in Carrollton after a brief illness. A daughter of the late Thomas and Anna Sitko, she was born December 8, 1923 in Akron Ohio. Ruth was a 1942 graduate of East High in Akron and a 1947 graduate of International Bible College in San Antonio, Texas. She spent many years in Akron where she worked as a secretary at the Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company. She married Edmond Neider on June 5, 1954. In 1959 she and her husband purchased a dairy farm and moved to Carrollton. Ruth then went to work for Attorney Glenn Fortune, and then for Affiliated Hospital Products.
