



## Ruth Morris Weir

June 7, 1924 - October 31, 2011

Ruth Morris Weir, 87, of Carrollton passed away following a courageous battle with cancer, in her home, surrounded by her family. Daughter of the late William Albert and Iva Lewton Morris, she was born June 7, 1924 in Elkton, Ohio. Ruth attended Fairmont One Room School for eight years before attending both Lisbon and Fairfield Centralized High Schools, graduating from Fairfield Centralized. She was a basketball player during her senior year of high school. After graduation she attended and graduated from Columbus Business College. Prior to marriage she worked as a secretary for Floyd Lower, Agriculture Agent at Columbiana County Extension office. A devout Christian, she was a longtime member of Corinth Presbyterian Church in Mechanicstown where she was an assistant pianist, member of the Women's Missionary Society. She was a 4H advisory for Little Women, life member of the Carroll Historical Society, Blossom Country Dancers, and the Republican Booster Club. She had been a precinct worker on election day for Washington Township. In her younger years Ruth enjoyed all aspects of homemaking, gardening, playing cards with good friends, and attending plays and musicals.
