



Sister Mary Huber

June 24, 1920 - June 27, 2012

Sister Mary Huber OLC of the Sisters of our Lady of Charity, died peacefully in Carrollton, Ohio on Wednesday, June 27, 2012 at the age of 92. Sister Mary was born June 24, 1920 in Cheswick, PA. She was the eldest daughter of the ten children born to John B. and Ida Schrafl Huber. In 1936, Sister entered the Sisters of Our Lady of Charity at the Home of the Good Shepherd Monastery, Troy Hill, Pittsburgh, PA. She has been a faithful member of the Order for 76 years. Sister worked for seventeen years with young women who were experiencing difficulties in their lives while at the Good Shepherd Home and another ten years at Gilmory School for Girls, Coraopolis, PA. She was Superior of the Sisters at Gilmory Convent and later at Eudes Institute, Plus Street, Pittsburgh, PA. Beginning in 1981 until her illness, Sister Mary worked with the elderly in Pittsburgh and in Carrollton, Ohio. Upon its opening in 2000, Sister was the first coordinator of Stapleton Hall providing care for our elderly and infirmed sisters. She was known for her compassion and her gentle care delivered with a smile or witty joke. Sister was also known for her prayerful support of the Sisters and their ministries as well as anyone who requested her prayers. Although from a large extended family, Sr. Mary never forgot to send a birthday or holiday greeting to each member even through this month of illness. Sister Mary was preceded in death by her parents, her brothers, Richard, John, Joseph, Philip, Frank, James, and David and her sister, Sister Therese Huber OLC. She is survived by the Sisters of Our Lady of Charity, her sister, Rita Shaughnessy, her sisters-in-law, Mary Ann and

Marietta Huber and numerous nieces, nephews, great nieces and nephews. Mass of Christian burial will be held Tuesday, July 3, 2012 at 9:30 A.M. in the Sisters of Our Lady Convent with Rev. Fr. Anthony Batt officiating. Burial will follow Tuesday afternoon at 2:00 P.M. at Christ the Redeemer Cemetery, North Side, Pittsburgh, PA at the Sisters of Our Lady of Charity graveside. Friends will be received at the Sisters of Our Lady Convent, 620 Roswell Road, NW, Carrollton, Ohio on Monday July 2, 2012 from 3 to 7 P.M. and Tuesday from 8:00 A.M. until time of the service.
