



## Sister Ann (Mary Margaret) White

December 7, 1920 - May 27, 2012

Sr. Ann (Mary Margaret) White OLC died peacefully at the Sisters of Our Lady of Charity convent in Carrollton on Pentecost Sunday, May 27, 2012. In her 92nd year, Sr. Ann was born December 7, 1920 in Wexford, Ireland, the oldest of twelve children of John and Anne Lawler White. Sister Ann came to the United States at the age of 33 to enter the Sisters of Our Lady of Charity in San Antonio, TX. She has been a member of the Congregation for the past 59 years. Sister graduated from Incarnate Word College with a BA degree in Elementary Education and from the University of Our Lady of the Lake with a MA in Education Administration. Sister began her teaching career at Our Lady of Victory School in San Antonio, TX and was principal for thirteen years until the school closed. She then served as principal at St. Gerard Elementary School in San Antonio. She also taught English as a Second Language for many years. Sister came to Carrollton, Ohio in 2004 where she continued her prayerful, quiet life of service until her death. She has been an example of commitment and dedication to all. Sister was preceded in death by her parents, her brother, Tom and her sisters, Annie Doyle and Bridie Cusack. She is survived by her brothers, James, Sean, Joseph, Liam and by her sisters, Margaret Sinnott, Joan Keogh, Celestine Fox, all of Ireland, Sister Eileen White of the Sisters of Jesus Our Hope, Bloomsbury, NJ and her province of the Sisters of Our Lady of Charity.
