T. Leila McKinney, 91, of Amsterdam Rd., Scio (Perrysville) died early Monday morning July 27, 2009 in the Carroll Healthcare Center in Carrollton. Born April 7, 1918 in Perrysville she was a daughter of the late Charles and Grace Custer Muze Stewart. Leila was an employee of the former Scio Pottery and had been a senior citizen transport driver for the Carroll County Friendship Center. She was a member of the Perrysville United Methodist church where at the time of her death she was the oldest member and had served as the church organist and pianist until 2008. Leila was also a member of the Carroll County Historical Society and played in the Algonquin Mill Band. Leila is survived by three daughters, Karen Kuligowski of Louisville, Ohio, Michelle (Benjamin) Crall of Carrollton, Jill (Gary) Henry of Carrollton; eight grandchildren; fifteen great grandchildren; two sisters, Melveen Dutenhaver of Carrollton, and Edith Newbold of Mechanicstown.
