



## Ted R. Ralston

May 24, 1922 - February 13, 2012

Ted R. Ralston, 89, of Carrollton passed away early Monday morning February 13, 2012 in the Carroll Golden Age Retreat. A son of the late Fred Raymond and Lola Lee Coleman Ralston, he was born May 24, 1922 in Mechanicstown, Ohio. Ted was a WWII veteran having served under General Patton in the European Theater. A standout pitcher in his youth, Ted also earned a tryout with the Pittsburgh Pirates professional baseball club. During his career he worked for Carrollton Manufacturing and United Dye Manufacturing in Sebring, Ohio. His memberships included life memberships in the Odd Fellows of Dellroy, Carrollton VFW, Carrollton Vets Club, and a member of the Carrollton Church of Christ Christian Disciples. He is survived by his daughter, Denise Ralston of Carrollton; a sister, Betty Carol Slonaker of Phoenix, Arizona; and numerous nieces and nephews. Along with his parents he was preceded in death by his wife, the former Donna Dennis, on January 8, 2006; five brothers and six sisters. Funeral services will be Thursday, February 16, 2012 at 11 a.m. in Sweeney-Dodds Funeral Home of Carrollton with Rev. Mike Doak officiating. Burial will follow in Woodlawn Cemetery of Salineville.
