Thomas W. Parker, 60, of Carrollton, passed away Monday afternoon at Aultman Hospital following a brief battle with cancer.

Born October 18, 1961 in Canton, he was the son of Donald Parker of Carrollton and the late Sandra Beadnell Parker.

Tom was a 1980 graduate of Carrollton High School. Since 1998 he was a partner at D&D Appliance in Carrollton. He had a love for Carrollton and the surrounding communities, he was a former Fire Chief for the Dellroy Fire Department, an avid supporter of youth sports in the area, supporter and former member of 4H, and for the last nine years he served on the Village Council of Carrollton.
