Timothy Johnson, 78, of Carrollton, Ohio, passed away on June 15, 2025, at the Truman Hospice House in New Philadelphia following a courageous battle with cancer.

Born March 10, 1947, in Martins Ferry, Ohio, he was a son of the late Clyde and Julia (Hudock) Johnson. Timothy dedicated over 30 years of his life to Timken Bearing, from where he retired with a reputation for hard work and reliability.

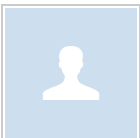
