William E. "Bill" Warner, 74, of Louisville, formerly of Carrollton, died Thursday evening December 14, 2017 at the Carroll Healthcare Center in Carrollton.

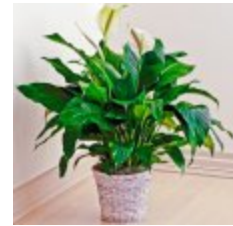
